



Stations of the Cross Assembly - 7th April 2017

- ✠ "A Journey to the Cross" - prayerful mediations with images by the Benedictine Sisters of Turvey Abbey.

The assembly was a reflective and prayerful journey from when Jesus was condemned to death through to the glorious event on Easter Sunday morning, The Risen Christ. Throughout the journey, the children highlighted specific articles from the UN's convention for the Rights of the Child and gave examples of the plight of children throughout the world who are not given these rights.

After the assembly, the pupils left the hall in prayerful silence.
