Welcome back everyone, we hope you had a wonderful summer and got up to lots of exciting things!

We have lots of exciting things in store for the children and can't wait to get started! Our topics for the autumn term are 'Pirates' and after October half term 'Fairytale.'

As the children are now in Year 1, we do ask that they do not bring toys into school as we do not want them to get lost or broken. May we also ask that children do not bring in water bottles unless they are having a packed lunch; children will have access to drinking water in the classroom throughout the day.

PE will be on a Tuesday afternoon - please make sure your child has their name in all of their clothes and shoes. Children should not be wearing jewelry or earrings to school and hair should be tied up with plain hair accessories.

Homework will be given out on a Friday and will be due in on the following Tuesday. **All homework books need to be in school for the Tuesday.** Spellings will be given out on a Wednesday and tested the following Wednesday.

Reading - your child will read individually with a teacher at least once a week where their book will be changed if needed. **It is essential that your child bring their book and diary into school everyday.** We will try and read as often as possible with your child so it may be different days each week. It is really important that they read each night - remember that it doesn't need to be the whole book; a few pages each night is fantastic!
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Please make sure that your child brings their planner in their book bag every day so that we can share information with you, as needed, and award merit stickers.
