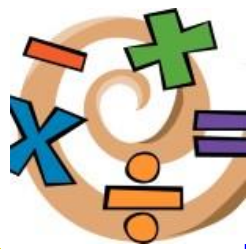

We will be finding out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching by applying a force.

We will learn that some materials can be found naturally, while others have to be made.
