Science Living Things and Their Habitats

Exploring the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.

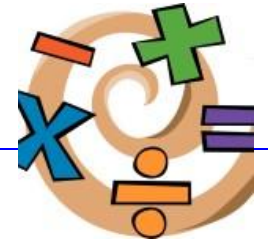
Wind in the Willows (Spring Term 2)

We will be designing and making our own puppets.

Music

Children will:

- play tuned and untuned instruments musically;
- listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high quality live and recorded music.
- experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.

PE – Dance

We will be working on moving to different pieces of music, using turns, travels and balances.

We will work on creating sequences and performing dances using simple movement patterns.

Maths

Understanding two-digit numbers – partitioning numbers in different ways, reading, writing, ordering, finding patterns

Completing addition and subtraction calculations and word problems

Completing multiplication and division calculations and word problems

Finding fractions of shapes, numbers and amounts. (halves, quarters and thirds)
