Objective 1: To ensure all pupils have sufficient challenge in lessons. The target is for all children to make at least expected progress and most pupils to make more than expected progress

This objective has been identified because: challenge for the most-able pupils was identified as an action in the OFSTED report (2016). We need to ensure that all children are challenged so that they achieve their potential.

Objective 2: To develop good speaking skills in all pupils

This objective has been identified because: the connection between developing oracy impacts positively on reading and particularly writing. The school has begun to develop 'Talk Less' Teaching for teachers with emphasis on pupil discussion and interaction.

Objective 3: To continue to develop support for pupil mental health and well-being

This objective has been identified because: in 2017-18 School achieved the Beyond Bullying Award (Gold) and is now continuing its well-being work. We are looking to achieve a Mental Health Award from Leeds Beckett University this year.

Objective 4: To increase the number of pupils in the school

This objective has been identified because: there are a number of free spaces in school. We hope to attract more parents by establishing a pre-school in 2019.

Objective 5: To raise standards in RE

This objective has been identified because: although we achieved an Outstanding judgement in the Diocesan Inspection in June 2017 standards in RE could be more consistent across year groups.
