Word	Definition
baptism	Baptism is the first sacrament which welcomes people into the Christian family.
John the Baptist	He was the last prophet of the Old Covenant who devoted his life to preparing the way for Jesus.
Holy Spirit	The one who speaks to people's hearts and helps them know they should receive Jesus as their Saviour.
temptation	Temptation is something that entices (encourages) you to act in a way that is displeasing to God.
sin	Sin is the bad things we do that makes God sad and separates us from him, often hurting us and other people.
miracle	When God uses His power to cause something to happen on Earth, it's called a miracle.
parable	A parable is a simple story that illustrates a moral or spiritual lesson, to teach a great truth or to challenge the hearers to change their own behaviour.
sorrow	Sorrow is a feeling of deep sadness. We feel sorrow when we have sinned against God.
forgiveness	Forgiveness is to let go of hurt feelings and make a new start.
reconciliation	Reconciliation is to make friends again after an argument or disagreement. When we say sorry and forgive others, we are reconciled with God.


It is the celebration of the visit of the wise men to see baby Jesus.
